REPORT OF THE SECRETARY

Progress of the Association from 01.01.2015 to 31.12.2015

The Association, as on 31st December, 2015, has 1,842 Ordinary Members and 2,432 Associate Members, totalling 4,274 members.

The members have generously contributed to the Corpus of the Association for its objectives. The Corpus contribution has been invested in interest bearing Fixed Deposits in Banks.

The income has been utilised for its objectives in the period under review by giving contribution inter alia for the following activities:

- 1) To Job Fair Programme for Indore and Haridwar.
- 2) Continuing financial support for AADEIs Chair in Hindustani Classical Music (Tabla) at DEI.
- 3) Under graduate Research Award scheme (UGRA).
- 4) Development of "AADEIs Transit Accommodation" at 45-C, Manglam Estate, Dayalbagh.
- 5) To Soami Nagar Model School, New Delhi for Interschool events and workshops.
- 6) To DEI for establishing DEI ICT Distance Education Centre at Amritsar (Punjab).
- 7) Contribution to DEI for research in "Quantum Information and Consciousness" upgradation of the 2 Channel Magneto Encephalogram (MEG) equipment at the Quantum-Nano Systems Centre to 15-channels.
- 8) To Middle India Radhasoami Education Society towards construction of Primary School, Recreation Centre and Community Hall etc. in Tribal area of Madhya Pradesh.

The programmes of DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Soami Nagar, New Delhi, and DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Bangalore have grown substantially and these now also help run a number of DEI courses. AADEIs are contributing the expenditure on running these Centres.

Courses which help the students and job seekers in placement and otherwise are being conducted regularly at AADEIs ICT Continuing Education Centre DEI, Dayalbagh, and a large number of students of DEI, Distance Education Centres, alumni and unemployed youth have benefited from these.

Setting up more such ICT Centres in other parts of the country is under consideration. AADEIs teams at Delhi and spread over different parts of the Country have helped develop courses materials and arrange teachers for DEI students on various subjects.

Your Executive Committee places on record its appreciation of the excellent work being done by the Administrators at DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Soami Nagar, New Delhi, AADEIs ICT Continuing Education Centre DEI, Dayalbagh and DEI ICT Distance Education Centre, Bangalore.

The Alumni Placement Assistance Cell (APAC) of AADEIs continues to conduct its training and placement programmes such as job fairs for students, alumni and other unemployed youth with commendable vigour. It is also coordinating with the industry in launching the DEI's innovative Cooperative programme.
