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Centenary of Dayalbagh Education Celebrated at Faculty of Engineering

An Exhibition on the History of Engineering Education in Dayalbagh was impressively displayed on all three days that not only applauded the glorious past in the form of erstwhile Engineering College, but also the bright present of the Faculty. The three-day Workshop on Robotics garnered lot of attention and interest of the students, which could be seen in their participation in large numbers. The students also got a chance to display their sporty side through events like Tug-of-War and Volley Ball Matches. 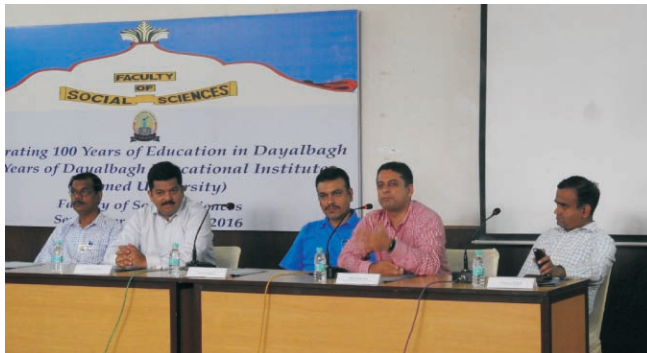
Some other highlights of the celebrations were, Interaction with Alumni, Special Talks by eminent

DEI Students Display Vivacity in Youth Parliament



In the group level competition of Model Youth Parliament conducted by the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, the students of DEI presented a perfect pattern of working of the Lok Sabha on 14 September, 2016. The Hall at the International Seminar Complex of the Institute was looking like a striking model of the Chamber of the Indian Parliament, with Speaker seated at the centre of the House, members of the Opposition seated on the left of the rostrum and the seats for the government benches on the right of the rostrum. There was also a gallery for the Press and the Foreign Delegates.

The practices and proceedings, which are normally taken up in the Lok Sabha Session, were immaculately exhibited by the student representatives of DEI, who seemed to be well acquainted with the current social and civil issues. During the Question Hour, the representatives of the Opposition (Kanishka Kohli, Saloni and Mahima Satsangi) raised the issues related to Internal Security, Sports and Water-crisis and took the Government to task. Chaudhary and Abhinav Dayal Saxena, who were representing the ruling party, showed a lot of wit and dynamism in giving balanced answers to these questions/charges. Ambika Reddy, as the Human Resource Development Minister, presented a Bill related to 'Common School System'. Addressing the issues and charges related to Reservation and Education, Udit Tiwari, in the role of the Prime Minister, appealed to all the members of the House to work in co-operation and solve the difficulties keeping public interest in view. The session was presided over by Rhimanshi Mukund who was present as the Speaker of the House.

The Jury for estimating the performance comprised eminent personalities like, Sh. Babulal, Honourable Member of Parliament, Prof. Kushal Sen from Delhi University and Prof. Dinesh Arora from D.A.V. College, Jalandhar. Inauguration of DEI-TVS Community College in DEI Campus



The Dayalbagh Educational Institute and TVS Motor Co. Ltd signed an MoU on 22 September 2016 to start the DEI-TVS Community College, in the DEI campus. Here, two programmes, one for Sales training and another for Service training will be offered.

Prof. Prem Kumar Kalra, Director, DEI signed the MoU on behalf of DEI and Dr. V. Kovaichelvan, Senior Vice President-HR signed it on behalf of TVSM. A modern Training Workshop, along with two classrooms, was also inaugurated. The Workshop will cater to the training needs of the enrolled students. The Workshop is equipped with two lifts, parts cleaner, battery charger, spark plug cleaner & tester, nitrogen tyre filling in addition to general & special tools and other equipment, cut-section models & engines, and a variety of scooters and motorcycles for student practice. Two trainers underwent basic training at the company’s plant at Hosur. They also underwent special training at the company’s Training Centres for Sales and Service respectively.

The programme was well attended by around 30 representatives of TVSM dealers of UP & Delhi and some company officials. The dealers were happy to see the facilities in the Training Workshop and have high hopes of getting trained manpower from DEI.

Dr. V. Kovaichelven stressed that trained manpower is the need of the hour. Shri Niraj Kumar, GM - Service, TVSM said that both TVSM and DEI

have a 100 year history and their coming together will benefit the underprivileged youth of the society. Shri. U.B. Pandey, Associate Vice President - Sales and Regional Business Head (North), spoke on improving customer experience. Prof. Kalra, Director, DEI suggested to Dr. Kovaichelvan that DEI and TVSM could take such social responsibility initiatives in other places also where DEI has its presence, for the benefit of the backward and underprivileged sections of the society. Prof. Anand Mohan, Registrar, DEI traced the genesis of today’s occasion and said that in Dayalbagh and DEI we move forward with evolution rather than revolution. He further said that such progress is always stable and sustainable. Dr B.B. The two programmes envisage 1 module of classroom training, comprising both theory and practice, and thereafter 3 modules of on-the-job training at the company’s dealerships in the hometown of the student. After successful completion of the training, the student will be offered employment in the company’s dealership and the dealer will reimburse his course fees. The student will also be given two sets of college uniform free of charge. These two courses will commence with Module 2 of DEI.

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
