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TSC 2015 (June 8-13, 2015), Helsinki, Finland

Toward a Science of Consciousness Conference

A large delegation from DEI, comprising around 50 faculty members, research scholars and students visited Helsinki, Finland for the Toward a Science of Consciousness Conference (TSC 2015) organized from June 8-13, 2015 for both the East-West Forum on June 8 as well as the main event in the following days.

A pre-event rehearsal TSC@DEI 2015 was held at DEI on May 21, 2015. The East-West Forum on June 8 was held in video-conferenced mode with DEI, Dayalbagh and was attended by around 100 delegates, 60 from the West and 40 from India. The Vision Talk was delivered from Dayalbagh by Revered Prof. P.S. Satsangi, Chairman, Advisory Committee on Education, Dayalbagh Educational Institutions. Panel Discussion was held on "Consciousness: Integrating Eastern and Western



Perspectives" with notable inputs from DEI also. Among the foreign experts at the East-West Forum were Prof. Stuart Hameroff, Prof. Rocco J Gennaro, Dr. Anirban Bandyopadhyay, Prof. Mani Lal Bhaumik, Prof. John Hagelin, Dr. Tarja Kallio-Tamminen, Prof. Max Velmans and Dr. Douglas Friesen.

In the subsequent days, DEI delegation participated fully in the main event from June 9-13. DEI concur-



rent talk and posters were held on June 10. The Poster session involved lot of discussion and continued till late in the evening. The conference has now been named as 'The Science of Consciousness' (TSC 2016 onwards) instead of 'Toward a Science of Consciousness' (till TSC 2015). TSC 2016 will be organized at Tucson, Arizona and Prof. Hameroff has invited DEI to conduct East-West Forum on April 25, 2016.

SCI-HIGH 2015 (March 2-9, 2015)

Summer School in Science for High School Students

It was a great learning experiment for Dayalbagh Educational Institute to organize the Summer School in Science for High School Students (SCI-HIGH 2015) from March 2 to March 9. The school comprised of 1-hour expert lectures to provide a window on state of the art topics such as quantum computing, nano computing, internet technologies, multimedia technologies, computer vision, solar power, biotechnology, green chemistry, opportunities and frontiers in life sciences, VLSI technologies, Photonics, Medical Science and Physiology, Virtual Labs and Scientific Instrumentation among others. These serve as an eye-opener to the visions for the 21st century for the students and provided them a glimpse of the wonderful opportunities that lie ahead in science. The school also had visits to several labs including SQUID systems in Magnetically Shielded Room at Quantum-Nano Centre and Solar Power Plant to provide a first-hand view of science in action. Prof. S.C. Dutta Roy, Former Professor, IIT Delhi, delivered the Valedictory Talk entitled "The Road Ahead" on March 9. We have







also taken a leaf out of Engineering Science Quest programme organized by University of Waterloo to enhance the SCI-HIGH programme with workshops and camps to spark the imagination of students.
